## **Revival in the Body of Christ**

*As for me, I will call upon God, and the Lord shall save me. Evening and morning and at noon I will pray, and cry aloud, and He shall hear my voice. (Ps.55:16-17).* Throughout the Psalm it is evident that the writer is deeply disappointed by the attitude of some of his friends. This situation however, did not turn him away from God, but instead he remained at a place of intimacy with His God. In this writing he is completely honest about His emotions and hides nothing from His Maker, placing His trust completely in God. **Father, You are our Refuge in times of trouble. ## **Testimony: 60 000 people pray together**

You can see almost anything at Times Square in Manhattan. But 60,000 people praying? That's an unusual sight in the heart of Broadway. Yet, that's just what happened on 20 September 2009 for one hour – from 3 p.m. to 4 p.m. in a Christian rally called Prayer in the Square. Event organizers had expected some 15,000. But their expectations were far exceeded at the third event of its kind in the last three years.
