## **Revival in the Body of Christ**

*I am the Almighty God; walk before me and be blameless. And I will make My covenant between Me and you, and will multiply you exceedingly. Then Abram fell on his face... (Gen.17:1b-3a).* God has the same message for us today; to walk in unity with Him and be blameless. We are to obey God in every respect because He is God – that is reason enough. Abram's response when God spoke to Him was one of respect and honour – he fell on His face. Are we still captivated by awe and wonder when we hear God speak to us, or has His presence become too familiar? **Heavenly Father, we bow down before You. We desire Your presence in our lives daily and we want to please You in all things. We will not fear; for You are our Shield and exceedingly great reward.**

## **Testimony: Revival in Muslim Algeria**

Despite laws preventing conversion, Muslims are turning to Christ in what's being called an amazing move of the Spirit in Northern Algeria. In 2008, Algeria put into full effect a new anti-conversion law that prohibited efforts to convert Muslims to another religion and gave the government the right to regulate every aspect of Christian practice. This law was a direct attack against Christians since almost all Algerian Christians are converts from Islam. The new law could make nearly all Christian churches in the country illegal. Despite this new law, 2009 has been an incredible year for evangelical church growth. Some churches have grown 802%. Many converts have come from Islam with no Christian heritage, no Christian background, no resources whatsoever, no training. But they just believe in God and His Word. Pray that God will give them the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him and that the eyes of their understanding will be enlightened. (Eph.1:17-18). Pray that they will become skilled at the word of righteousness so that they can discern between good and evil. (Heb.5:13-14).**

## **Pray for your community: Teenagers risk death**

Children are posting videos on the Internet showing them choking other youngsters to the point of collapse, in a craze that doctors warn has led to brain damage and death. In one such case a group of teenagers set out clear guidelines to the practice in an 'instructional video', while in several others British voices can be heard. The problem has been increasingly acknowledged in the United States, Canada and France but campaigners warn that Britain is turning a blind eye. In Britain, the Department for Children, Schools and Families said it was aware of the activity and was monitoring the situation closely. There is no authoritative research on the issue in the UK, despite campaign groups compiling 86 cases of young people in Britain who may have died this way. Ask Jesus to reveal Himself to them, for He is the One who has abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel. (2 Tim.1:10).**

## **South Africa: Children without supervision**

They are only eight and 10 years old, but these sisters live alone and take care of themselves. They stay in a door-less-brick building in their grandmother's yard but don't rely on her for anything. The girls go to school but leave whenever they want and wonder around their neighbourhood looking for food. Their mother spends her money on drinking with friends. Pray for parents; that they will take care of their children as God has ordained.**

## **International: Pray for Kids in Haiti**

Up to two million children are feared orphaned or at least separated from their parents in Haiti. The concern arises after Haiti was hit by a 7.0-magnitude earthquake. There are growing concerns about their safety as looters prowl. The prison also collapsed, and inmates are roaming the streets. There are a number of ministries that are accommodating orphans. The kids hear this message: "We're going to care for you until you are a young adult. We're going to educate you, we're going to love you, and we're going to teach you about Jesus Christ. We want you to be the Godly change agent of the future Haiti." (Website: <http://www.mnnonline.org/article/13762>, 18/01/10). **Pray that the orphans will be able to find rest and comfort in God. Pray that the orphans will be responsive to the message of hope that is shared with them. Pray for the sufficient supply of food, clothes and medical supplies for the children.**
