Please forgive us. May the conviction of Your Spirit become so urgent in our hearts that we would not dare to do anything that is not according to Your purposes.**

Trung had malaria, medicine had no effect, his health deteriorated and he expected to die. Childhood memories of stories about Jesus resurfaced and he prayed for healing went to lie down and went to sleep. At about midnight he heard the Lord call his name. He was startled and as he sat up in bed he felt God's peace come over him. It seemed to bring healing and in the morning I felt well. The Lord answered his prayer and he remained malaria-free. Trung evangelized and preached freely following his conversion, was arrested for his faith, beaten, released, and continues to serve God in Vietnam in spite of the pain in his chest due to the beatings he received in prison. Infections are common and now life-threatening. While lives are still at risk, many have already forgotten Haiti. The media has turned their attention elsewhere. The Church is encouraged to continue to cry out to God on behalf of the Haitians. Christians have been able to share their faith in the midst of tragedy. But the tragedy will grow as the rainy season hits. The rainy season is going to exacerbate the problem with diseases like cholera breaking out – a disease that is not common in Haiti.
